



Warman High School In-Town Busing

Warman in-town busing is offered to Warman High School students, based on their distance from the school. The Prairie Spirit Board of Education determined the criteria for in-town busing in the Town of Warman. In-town busing is only available for those Warman High School students living within the boundaries shown on the following maps.

Only new students to Warman High School (including those students transferring from Warman Elementary School) will need to complete a bus transportation request form.

Warman in-town bus transportation request forms are available on the Prairie Spirit [website](#) or at the Division Office at 121 Klassen Street East, Warman. Once the request form is completed and processed, the student will be given a bus pass.

Only students with bus passes will be allowed to ride the bus. The bus pass details the number of the bus route determined for the student (see following maps for clarification); the student must get on the bus at that particular bus stop.

2010/11 School Year

A new high school bus stop (#9) has been added at the corner of Nicklaus Drive and Nicklaus Gate (south side) for Grade 6 - 12 students who live north of an east/west line drawn down the middle of the north portion of Faldo Crescent and Watson Way west to Centennial Boulevard (Bus #289: leave time: 8:26 a.m.; drop off time: 3:21 p.m.).

There has been an adjustment in times for the #1 bus stop (leave time: 8:17 a.m.; drop off time: 3:28 p.m.) and #5 bus stop (leave time: 8:20 a.m.; drop off time: 3:31 p.m.).

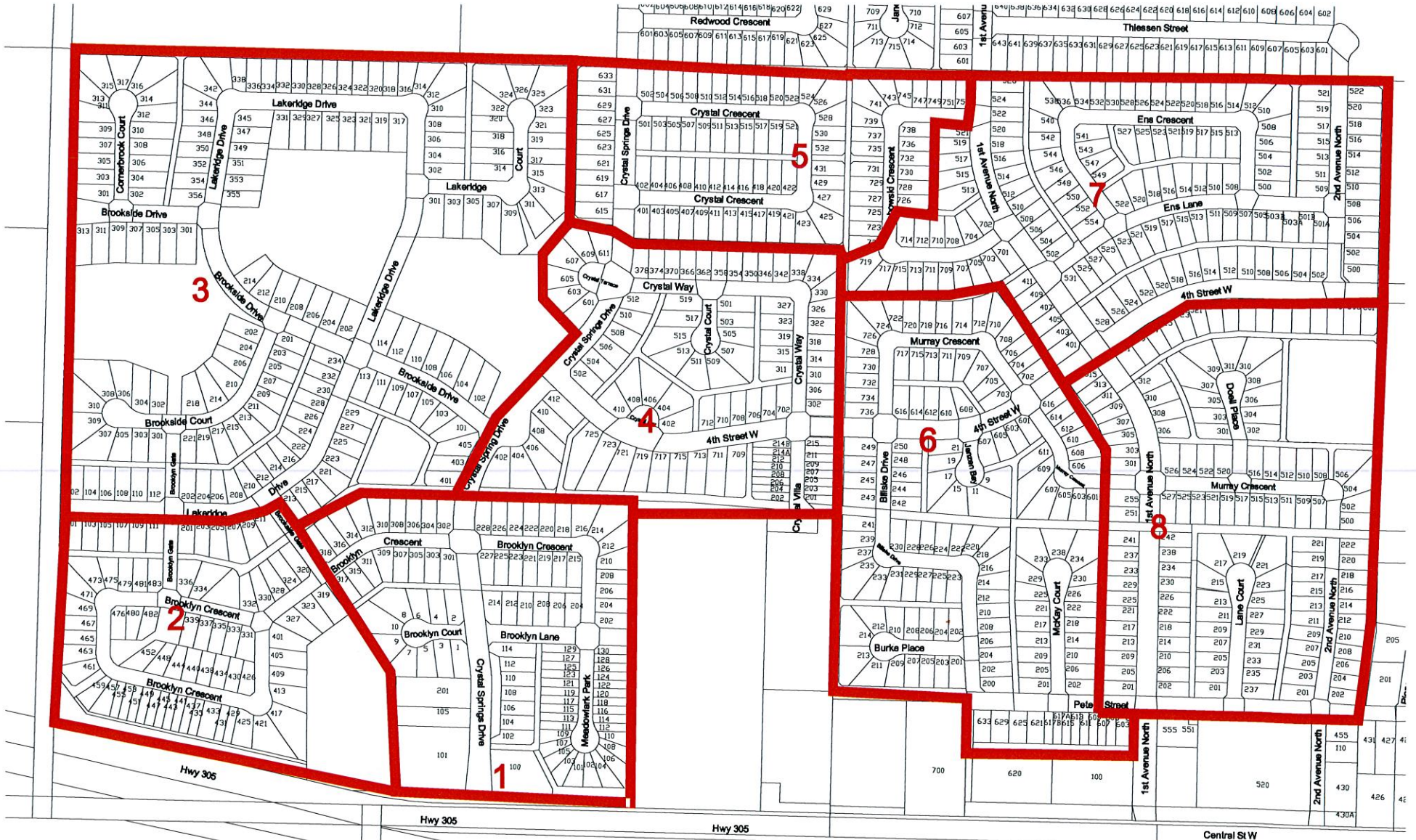

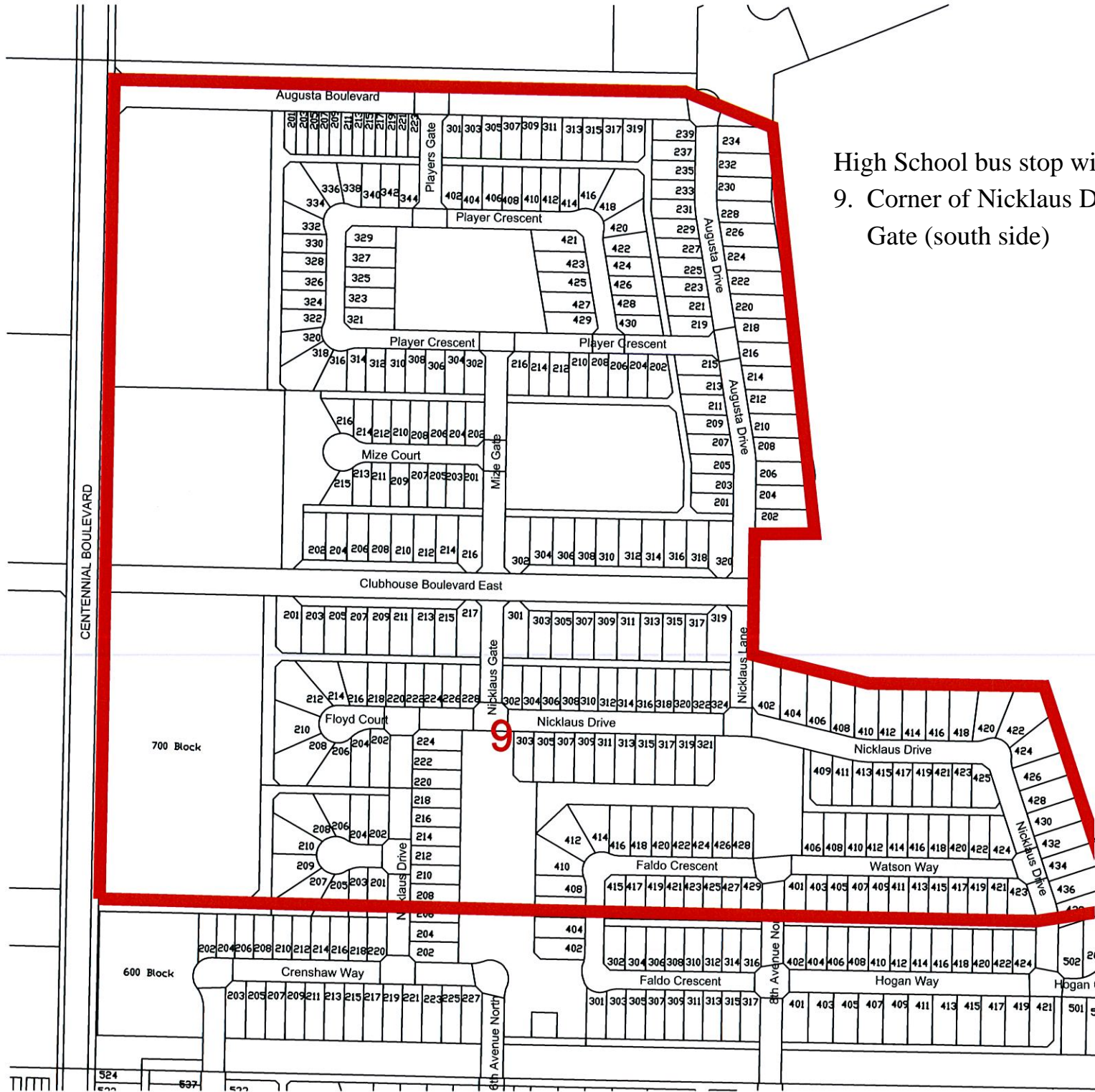
